Who qualifies to pay the Resident fees?

The Resident fee is determined by your home address and whether or not you reside within the Carbondale Park District taxing area. **You must reside (live) within the Carbondale City limits to receive the resident rate.** Otherwise, you are considered a Non- Resident. To prove residency, you must present a current (unexpired) photo ID and proof of Carbondale address. Examples are a recent piece of mail addressed to you (not junk mail), a bill in your name, or your property tax bill. Residency can be established at the Lakeland Center at 925 S. Giant City Rd. You will see these fees expressed in this guide as "R" and "NR".

Minimum/Maximum Participation Policy

Program fees are based on a minimum number of participants signing up. The minimum number of enrollees is necessary to cover the cost of offering the program. If less than the minimum number of participants required are enrolled at the registration deadline, the Carbondale Park District reserves the right to cancel that program. Those enrolled will be notified of the cancellation and will receive a full refund by mail. The maximum number of participants is determined based on safety, facility limitations, and quality assurance.

Program Cancellation Refund

When a program is cancelled by the Carbondale Park District, for any reason, a 100% program registration fee refund will be issued to each canceled program registrant.

Refund Policy

A 100% program registration fee refund will be issued only if a request for a refund is made no less than three business days prior to the start of the program. A 50% program registration fee refund will be issued only if a written request for a refund is received prior to the second scheduled meeting of the program. **There will be no program registration fee refunds given after the second scheduled meeting of the program except as defined under Medical Refund Requests.**

Medical Refund Request

A pro-rated program registration fee will be issued based up on the number of sessions remaining in a program only if a written request accompanied with medical documentation has been received identifying a medical problem which prohibits the individual's continued program participation. Such written requests for a refund due to medical reasons must be received within three (3) business days following the completion of the last scheduled meeting of the program. No refunds will be given thereafter.

Insurance

The Carbondale Park District assumes no responsibility for injuries or accidents occurring at programs or activities. It does not carry medical or loss of personal property insurance for program participants – the cost would make program fees prohibitive. It is advisable to review your own personal insurance plan to be certain that you and your family have proper coverage.

Rentals

The Carbondale Park District has many spaces available to rent for your next event! There are spaces available at Attucks Park, the Lakeland Center, Hickory Lodge, and Hickory Ridge Public Golf Center. For pricing and other information, please call 618-549-4222.



PetSafe Carbondale Community Dog Park Inside Parrish Park, 2500 W. Sunset Dr.

We want everyone to have a happy, safe experience while at the dog park.

Courtesy is contagious!

PLEASE abide by these rules so all dogs and humans can enjoy this park.

Rules for Dogs

Aggressive dogs are prohibited.

1. Dogs displaying aggression must be removed immediately.
2. Dogs must be at least 4 months old.
3. Spayed/neutered dogs are highly recommended.

INTACT MALES are to be monitored closely for any problems. FEMALES IN HEAT are prohibited.
4. Dogs must be leashed outside of the dog park and unleashed inside the park.
5. No dogs without people and no people without dogs allowed in the park.
6. Dogs that bark excessively must be quieted or removed from the park.
7. Dogs should wear flat collars of nylon, leather, etc. No chain, spike, harness, or metal collars allowed.
8. Dogs must be up to date on all rabies and other vaccinations. Dogs should wear their license and rabies tags on their collars. No sick or injured dogs allowed.
9. Dogs OVER 30-35 pounds (*Large Dogs*) ARE NOT ALLOWED in the Small Dog area, if Small Dogs are present. Dogs UNDER 30-35 pounds (*Small Dogs*) SHOULD USE the Small Dog area. Small Dogs that enter the Large Dog area do so at their own risk. If a problem occurs, the small dog must be removed.

Rules for Humans

Owners are legally and financially responsible for injuries or damages caused by their dog(s).

1. Guests assume all the risks when entering the dog park. PAY ATTENTION to your dog's behavior at all times.
2. Owners must pick up and properly dispose of their dog's waste. Bags are provided. Help keep our park clean.
3. Owners must make sure gates close when entering and exiting the park.
4. Owners should be inside the park with their dogs.
5. Owners should stop dogs from digging. Fill in holes made by your dog.
6. Owners are allowed up to 3 dogs per visit.
7. No children under 8 allowed in the park. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
8. Owners are not allowed to bring alcohol, tobacco, glass containers or FOOD (*human or dog treats*) into the park.
9. Owners are to closely monitor rough play and be ready to remove their dog if it escalates.
10. Owners who disobey or ignore the rules regarding usage of the park will be asked to leave the park and may be suspended from the park.

All rules and regulations are in place to protect all people and dogs visiting the park, as well as promote responsible dog ownership in our community. Healthy, well-socialized and exercised dogs not only make great family members, but great neighbors too!
